

Suction systems by Dürr Dental really make a difference! The range of V- and VS Suction Units for the practice surgery enables up to four operators to work simultaneously.



VS stands for “vacuum generation” and “separation”. The wet suction systems combine aspiration and separation centrally on a transport drive in a VS suction unit.



Special solutions like the VSA 300 S are ideally suited for a single treatment station. Also ideal is the mobile suction unit Variosuc or VC 45.



In the case of dry air suction systems, the separation function is integrated into the treatment units. Only dry air reaches the V Suction Unit.



Using both, Orotol® plus and MD 555 cleaner together will protect all suction unit components – including the pipe system! against deposits, contamination, and incrustation.

The aspiration of germ-laden spray mist

What is taken for granted today was a real sensation in the 1960s:

The treatment of patients in a supine position. This only became possible once Dürr Dental developed its systematic suction method.



High suction power for safe treatment

Suction systems have to meet extremely high requirements. Despite ongoing exposure to waste water, blood, saliva, dentine, and various filling materials (e.g. plastic, ceramic, and precious metals), they must produce their full suction power at all times. Without aspiration, an aerosol cloud would spread throughout the entire treatment room as a result of the cool spray of modern, fast-running instruments. This aerosol cloud contains germs, bacteria, and viruses. The resulting risk of infection is efficiently reduced through this systematic suction technology with a suction power of around 300 l/min. The suction power is generated by the suction unit – the driving force of the suction system.

The suction systems of market leader Dürr Dental deliver top performance when it comes to suction power. Thanks to their robust design, they have an extremely long service life while reducing maintenance efforts. Investing in a Dürr Dental suction system really pays off – not only through the facilitation of daily treatment but also because such systems reduce operating and maintenance costs.

Finding the right suction system

Whether your surgery has one or several treatment rooms, Dürer Dental has the solution you need.

The power of the suction systems is based on a factor of 300, which represents a suction power of 300 l/min on the large suction cannula. For example, the V 600 has the power of two operator workstations working at the same time.




Discover the difference!

However, when it comes to the needs of a particular surgery, the required power and number of rooms and operators are not the only important issues. In addition, technical matters relating to the architecture, structure, and facilities need to be taken into account. Suction systems by Dürr Dental can be installed easily and flexibly – in a basement, adjoining room, or in the treatment room itself.

Exceptionally quiet


The aerodynamic turbine wheels and integrated sound suppressors ensure low-noise operation.

The integrated auxiliary air valve regulates the suction power and ensures sufficient internal cooling.

Integrated humidity protection

In order to protect against condensed water, all dry V suction units are fitted with a condensate separator.



The wet VS Suction Systems

Dürr Dental provides the right suction solution for every surgery.

When it comes to the remodelling or modernization of a dental surgery, VS combination suction units can be used even in difficult installation conditions.

Powerful and cost-effective

“VS” stands for the combination of vacuum generation and separation. VS suction units are called wet systems because the entire suction and separation function is combined centrally in a VS suction unit on one drive shaft. This allows significant savings to be made. For example, there is no need for separate separation machines on the Dental Units and some of the operating costs of traditional systems – such as water ring pumps – are no longer relevant.

Dürr Dental VS Suction Systems are power packs that you can rely on. They can aspirate large quantities of liquids and serve up to four operators at the same time without interruption. Thanks to the integrated two-stage separation system, the aspiration of secretions and blood foam into the turbine space is reliably prevented. The drive of the combination suction unit runs smoothly and without vibration and is extremely reliable. All important functional elements have corrosion protection finish, which contribute to their extraordinary long service lives.

Perfect pipe system cleaning and hygiene

Central installation in a dental surgery with several treatment rooms places great demands on the cleaning and hygiene of the pipe system. With this in mind, Dürr Dental has developed the "tidal wave". This is a flow accelerator. It collects the waste water from the spittoon so that it can then be aspirated in flushes by the central suction unit. As a result, the suction unit independently eliminates the risk of deposits, unpleasant odours, and hygiene relevant situations.

VSA 300 S – three components in one unit

Taking all requirements of a suction system into account, the suction unit needs to separate the air/secretion solids mix and to separate the amalgam particles and collect them in a collector vessel. And it should do all this as economically and ecologically as possible. This sounds like a major system with corresponding costs. The VSA technology allows Dürr Dental to run all three components – the suction motor, separation unit, and amalgam separator – in one system unit and on one shaft in as little space as possible – in the form of the VSA 300 S.



The VSA 300 S is really easy to install in a basement room, a room adjoining the surgery, or in the treatment room itself

VC 45 – the surgical suction unit for implantology and OMF surgery

The VC 45 surgical suction unit ensures smooth surgical operations. The device performs quietly but impressively and meets the high requirements of implantology, oral surgery, and OMF surgery. With its powerful and robust membrane pump and container system, the device accurately removes large quantities of blood and gum, dentine, and bone residue. The continuous move adjustable VC 45 surgical suction unit works with a suction volume of 45 l/min and a constant vacuum of up to 910 mbar.



The multi-use secretion containers are made from high-quality plastic and can be autoclaved. Alternatively, disposable containers are available.

High-quality, robust drive motors, reliable continuous operation, great suction power within seconds, and flexible installation options.

Amazing power

The dry air suction systems by Dürr Dental are extremely powerful yet run really quietly. The V suction units are called dry systems because the aspirated substances are quickly guided into a separation/amalgam elimination unit. These components are integrated into the Dental Unit. Only dry air reaches the suction unit.

Seven to eight hours of continuous operation are not unusual. This places high demands on the technology. Dürr Dental V suction machines fulfil these requirements tirelessly. The contact-free, rotating turbine wheels generate the required vacuum and flow rate (suction power). A reliable electric motor enables non-stop operation. To reliably protect against condensed water, all models are fitted with a condensate separator as standard.

Around half of all suction units suffer from restricted performance due to deposits and blockages.

This is because most units are disinfected but are not cleaned as well. This results in substances such as blood, secretions, tooth material, filling materials, and prophylaxis powder forming a dense sludge. Consequently, blockages occur in the suction unit, causing a drop in power and – in the worst case scenario – complete standstill.


